NYS PASSES NO FAULT DIVORCE LEGISLATION - EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 12

With this recent bill, signed by Governor Paterson in August, New York became the 50th state to enact no fault divorce in some manner.

MCBA's Family Law Section has developed a program to cover what divorce practitioners need to know about the new no-fault divorce option that allows spouses to terminate their marriage within six months of stating under oath that their unions are "irretrievably" broken.
