



2011 Survey of Florida Law Update Available at MCBA

Each year, the Monroe County Bar Center for Education obtains the Survey of Florida Law Update recorded programs so that attorneys licensed in Florida can earn Florida continuing education credit more easily. The 2011 tapes were recently issued and are available. These qualify for 12.5 hours of general Florida CLER credit, including 4.0 hours of ethics. Florida credit no longer qualifies for New York State CLE due to a change in Florida requirements.

The topics covered in the audiotapes are: Trial Skills: Preserving the Record for Appeal; Ethics; Family and Medical Leave Act; Pretrial Publicity and Your Client: Issues and Ethics; Don't Leave Home Without It (Proper Tax Advice); Facebook and Other Electronic Social Networks: The Latest Minefield of Evidence Issues; Ethical Considerations in Evidence Law; Health Care Planning and End of Life Decisions; Foreclosure and Real Estate Case Law Update; Approach to Preserving Values & Leans; and, Foreclosures.

These are on compact discs and you will post these CLE credits online with Florida once you have listened to them.
