

Statement of Financial Affairs

From the Bankruptcy Court:

It appears that some bankruptcy petition preparation software is removing those pages of the "Statement of Financial Affairs" (SOFA) containing questions 19-25, if the debtor's answer to question 18 is "No." Please ensure that your software is configured so as to include the entire SOFA, even if the answers to questions 19-25 are in the negative.

The entire SOFA must be filed with the debtor's Petition. Both the Administrative Office of the US Courts and the United States Trustees agree that the entire SOFA must be included with the debtor's filing, even if the answers to questions 19-25 are in the negative.
